

# REQUEST MORE VOICE & SIGHT ACCESS IN THE NORTH TSA - DEADLINE IS JULY 19th

Since adoption of the Visitor Master Plan 10 years ago, 40 trails in Boulder's Open Space & Mountain Parks have experienced increased dog restrictions - many of those restrictions happened through the *Trail Study Area* (TSA) process.

## ***Let's reverse the trend of losing access!***

OSMP is currently in the midst of the *North Trail Study Area* (NTSA) and is in the process of gathering feedback from various stakeholder groups. They are utilizing a digital Town Hall web portal to take comments about what visitors "would like to see improved, changed or preserved in the North TSA and why".
