We sincerely hope you can make the City Council meeting this evening, or have written to the Council. **Here's some last minute tips on timing and organization.**

Please come to the meeting, and even better, sign up to speak. (To sign up online, go to and click on "electronic sign-up at <http://bouldercolorado.gov/city-council-up>."). Your fellow dog guardians need your support, and Council members need to see and hear your opposition to OSMP's extreme Green Tag proposals.

The future of the Green Tag Program, as we know it, is at stake.

The meeting starts at 6:00 PM at [City Council Chambers in the Municipal Building - 1777 Broadway](#). (map at the link)

The Green Tag discussion is expected to start at ~6:45 PM. Initially, there will likely be a presentation from OSMP staff, which will then be followed by the public comment session. You can sign up to speak at any time before the completion of the public comment session.

If you can't make the meeting, it will be **webcast live on Boulder Channel 8** at

from 6pm till 11pm. It will be under upcoming events.


